SAJO has had a successful 2018

- SAJO met the key benchmark of 12 peer reviewed publications per year in 2017 and 2018.
- These publications came from South Africa (17), Sudan (2), Cameroon, Kenya Nigeria, USA and Canada
- The publications have been heavily downloaded internationally with about 14 000 downloads of articles published in 2017 and 2018.
- There are already 5 articles, due to be published in 2019, which have gone through peer review.
- SAJO is on track to apply for accreditation from the SA Dept of Education in 2020.
